COURSE DESCRIPTION

ADMI's Sound Engineering programme trains students in all areas of sound production, including music production, studio recording, mixing, mastering and digital audio editing.

During their first year, students are introduced to the fundamentals of music production before progressing to live sound and studio recording. Over the course of the two years, students learn to operate state-of-the-art sound equipment and set up live gigs.

Graduates emerge from the programme with the technical skills they need to pursue careers as sound designers, dialogue editors, boom operators, and studio engineers.
